Now that you have created your characters, write some descriptive words to help us get to know them. Use words to tell us about their appearance, personalities, where they live and their favourite things.

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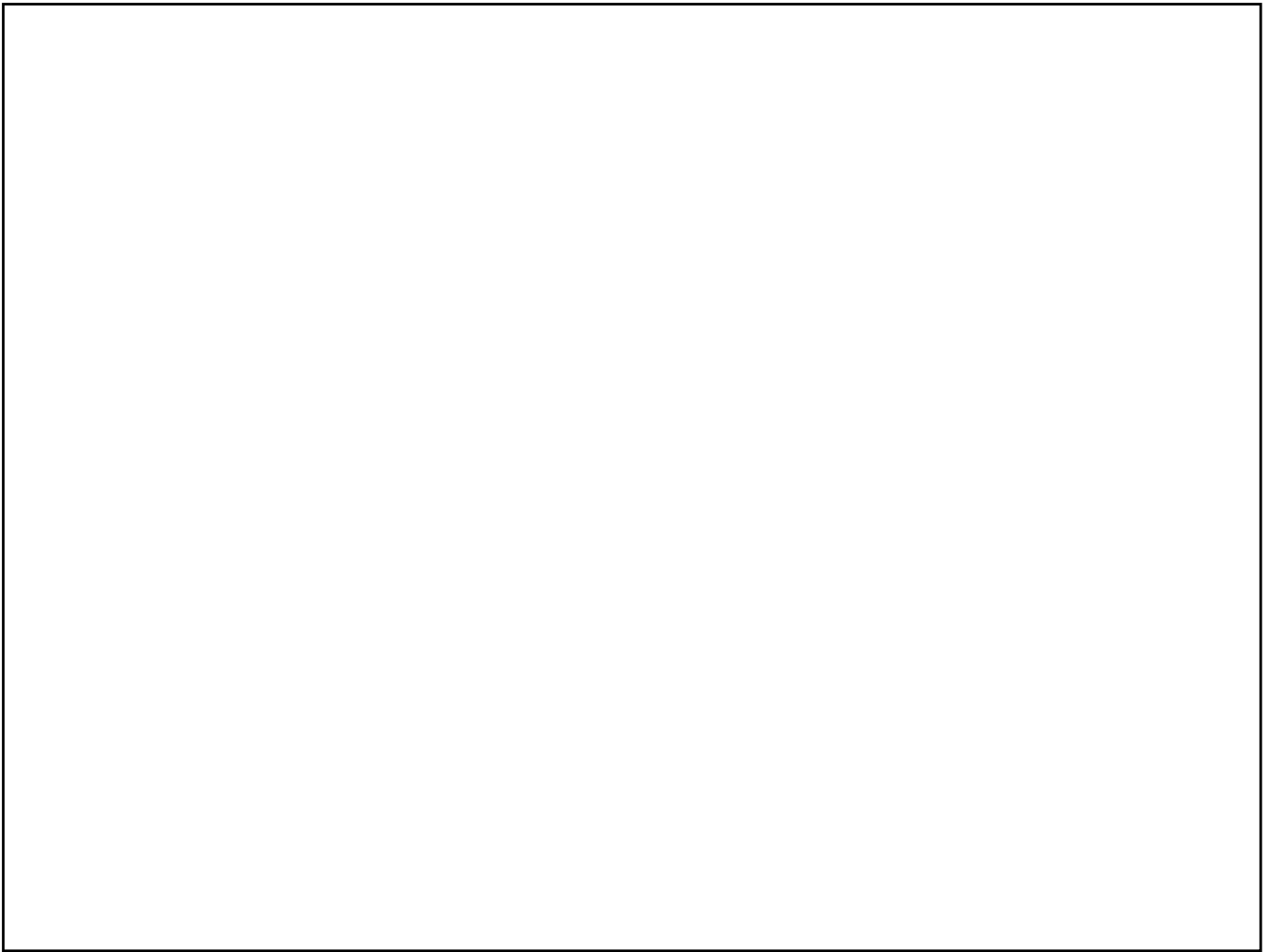

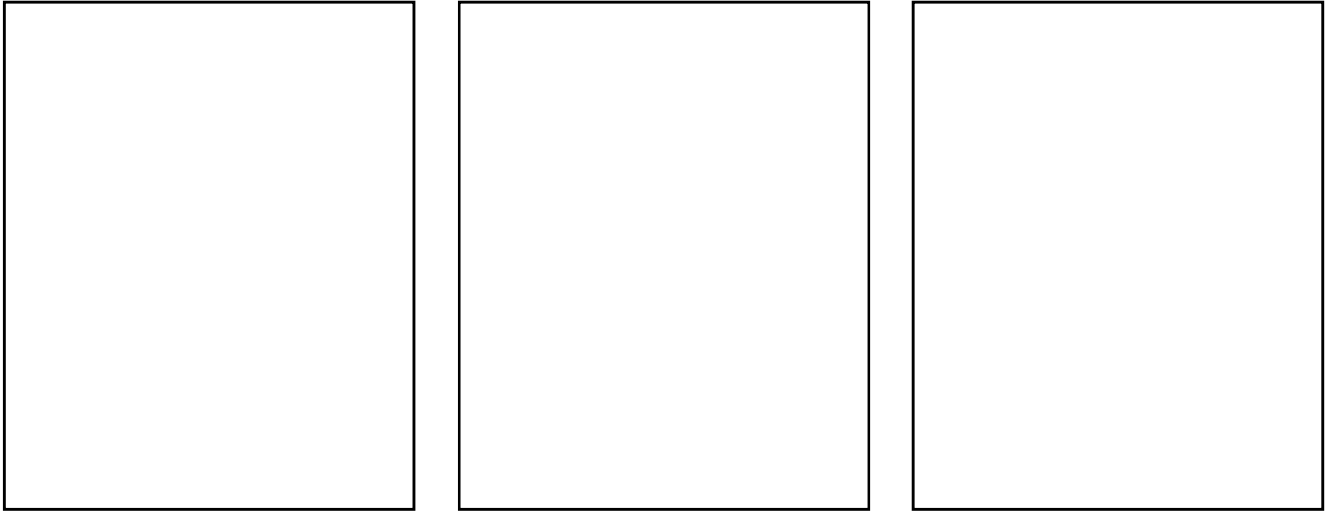
